From the North, South and East

Use M6 to Junction 16, then A500/A51 towards Nantwich/Chester. Follow the A500/A51, signposted Chester, for approximately 10 miles (you may notice that this is, in part, a new road) After approximately 8 miles you will by-pass Nantwich. Do not turn towards Nantwich. Continue on the A500/A51 signposted Chester. At roundabout take the second exit . The entrance to the Equestrian Centre is on the left hand side of the road approx. 50 yds from the roundabout.

From North Wales and Chester

Use A51 towards Nantwich. Follow A51 turning left at traffic lights on outskirts of Nantwich (still A51 and signposted Crewe/Congleton/Stoke/M6). Continue for approximately 1 mile and do not use the Main Hall entrance to Reaseheath College the entrance to Reaseheath College Equine Department is on the right hand side just before a small roundabout.

From South Wales and Shrewsbury via Whitchurch

Use A530 from Whitchurch for 8 miles to Nantwich. Bear right on passing Nantwich Lake on left. At Tjunction turn left, continue over level crossing and take first exit at roundabout. Continue over pedestrian crossing then at next traffic lights turn right (passing through town centre)At traffic lights at crossroads turn left. Pass straight through next set of traffic lights.

At roundabout take the first exit signposted Chester .The entrance to the Equestrian Centre College is on the left hand side of the road approx. 50 yds from the roundabout

All riders in Horse of the Year Show qualifying classes at this show must be members of the AHS before entering the ring. Random checks will be made by the AHS and any rider found not to have paid their membership fee before the commencement of the class will be disqualified from taking part. Any awards won by an exhibit later found to be ridden by a non-member will pass down to the next eligible exhibit and the result will be publicised. There will be no opportunity to retrospectively pay the fee.

Eligibility to qualify for Horse of the Year Show, N.E.C, Birmingham. 5th - 9th October 2016

RIDDEN PUREBRED ARAB OF THE YEAR

This competition is for Ridden Purebred Arabians. Owners of qualified horses must be members of the Arab Horse Society and the horse registered in their owner's name. The exhibitor must have purchased an AHS Q card displaying the name of the horse. This class will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.

This class will be divided into three sections as follows:

Section A Ridden Purebred Arab Gelding

Section B Ridden Purebred Arab Stallion

Section C Ridden Purebred Arab Mare

The qualifying horse will be the highest placed, previously unqualified, exhibit within the Championship of the mare, stallion and gelding sections. If a rider has qualified more than one horse, that rider will be allowed to exchange horses and ride each horse for its individual display. A groom is allowed into the ring to hold the horse whilst it is not being ridden.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 5th - 9th October 2016.

Qualification will not pass below 6th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

Owners of qualified horses must be members of the Arab Horse Society and the horse registered in their owner's name. The exhibitor must have purchased an AHS Q card displaying the name of the horse.

AHS Q Cards cost £25 per horse per season and must be purchased at least one week before the date of the class in which the horse will compete. Proceeds will be used for sponsorship at Horse of the Year Show.

Qualification will then pass down to the next eligible horse within the first six. There will be no opportunity to retrospectively pay the fee.

Classes 1 - 34 fall outside the jurisdiction of ECAHO and only the AHS Rules apply to them.

The British Amateur/Home Produced Arabian Championship is a qualifying competition open to registered **PURE/ANGLO-ARAB/PART BRED** Arabian Horses.

In Hand and Ridden Horses. Participants are not eligible for any ECAHO shows, which require qualification. A pre-purchased qualifying card will need to be taken into the ring for the judge to sign at the time of qualifying. You can qualify for BAHPAC at any AHS affiliated show. It may be in an open or amateur class. In order to qualify you must be one of the highest two PLACED amateurs NOT previously qualified in the class [(eg). in an open class if professionals are 1st, 2nd and 4th then the 3rd and 5th place will qualify. If the 3rd placed was an amateur who had already qualified then 5th and 6th would qualify.]

So basically ANY two highest placed, previously unqualified amateur in ANY class will be eligible. You need to have pre purchased your cards and take them in the ring with you. For further details go to www.bahpac.co.uk

This is a qualifying show for the Ridden Arabian Star Series (RASS). The highest two previously unqualified horses from within the first four in each RASS class will qualify to enter the Championship to be held at the UKIAHS at Addington Manor on 27th August 2016.

The highest place CARE horse with a RASS card will receive the CARE special sash and rosette.
Open to Ridden Pure Bred Arabians over 4 years of age which are registered in the correct Arab Horse Society Stud Book.

The highest placed previously unqualified horses from within the first four placings with a current qualification will qualify for the finals.

No qualification for the Series will be passed down in the event of a qualified exhibit withdrawn for any reason. Each horse wishing to qualify entering the class must have a RASS card which must be signed by the Judge in the ring.

C.A.R.E (Career after Racing or Endurance)

This class is for purebred Arabian horses 4 years old and over registered with the correct Arab Horse Society and owner is a member of the Arab Horses Society. To be eligible horses must have:

Raced or been in race training for a minimum of 8 weeks at a licence holding trainers premises.

Endurance horses to be currently competing or have competed for at least one season.

To collect RASS CARE category points exhibitors must have a current RASS card. Card costs £20.

Horses will not be ridden but will perform a show which will be marked by the Judge accordingly.

Horses must be bitted and wearing leather tack. A safety hat conforming to current standards **MUST** be worn by any riders under 18 and is strongly advised by the RASS committee. Please check if mandatory for the current show rules.. No RASS card required for entry to this class.

Potential Ridden Star 3 year old in hand class sponsored by Port Shipping Ltd

Open to 3 year old Purebred Arabian Horses. Mixed sex Class. Horses may wear in-hand show halter bridles or a snaffle bridle with plain/clenched/velvet browband. Noseband **must** be cavason.

3 year old colts **MUST** be bitted. Fillies/Geldings do not have to be bitted but may be if desired.

Horses will show a figure of 8 show in their individual show to exhibit pace, stride and balance.

A more relaxed pose will be sought.. **NO** bagging/rattling is allowed.. Applause is welcome..

Each horse wishing to qualify entering the class must have a RASS card which must be signed by the Judge in the ring.

RASS ALL STARS

A new series of in hand qualifying classes for 4 year old and over Purebred Arabian Horses, open to all exhibitors. To qualify for the Finals at Addington Manor Equestrian Centre in 2016, horses must have purchased a qualifying card from the RASS Committee. Horses not wishing to qualify for the Finals **CAN** still enter the classes, they just **CANNOT** qualify for the Finals without a qualifying card.

How to qualify...

Horses placed 1st or 2nd at ANY Royal or County show in the in hand Arab classes (four years old and over) can qualify for the finals by having their card signed (Mare/stallion/gelding or mixed purebred class).

OR Placing 1st to 3rd at a C or Group show in the ALL STARS in hand class male and female classes. Stallions and geldings to be shown together.

Classes may be split into sex or age divisions if sufficient horses are entered in any one section.

The rules of the classes....

Horses should be shown in a more relaxed manner than is accepted for ECAHO classes and display a 'softer' stand up than the Continental pose. No bagging is allowed in the collecting ring or during the class. However clapping and cheering along with crowd appreciation is encouraged.

Classes are to be judged on the current Arab breed class format and may be judged by single judge comparative system or points - whichever the hosting show is using.

Handlers should make every effort to be as smartly attired as possible, with men wearing shirts and ties in classes and ladies avoiding sleeveless, backless and short tops.

The Finals class at Addington will be judged on points. The champions can be any of the Top 5 horses brought forward.

Categories are free to enter. Points are gained by entering classes and the places achieved during the show season. Owner Handler, Owner Breeder, Young Handler (under 18), 40+ Handler, 50+ Handler, 60+ Handler, 15+ Horse

YOUNG HANDLERS/RIDERS

Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS015, EN1384 (USA) ASTM F1163 that meet current Safety Standards **MUST** be worn by riders 18 years and under. No spurs are allowed. No stallions are allowed.

Persons responsible for young handlers and riders under the age of eighteen must ensure that they are capable of controlling their exhibits. Age and ability must be taken into consideration when pairing handlers/riders to exhibits, to ensure their safety and the safety of others. **AHS Rules 32 / 41.** Young Handlers of horses/ponies in In Hand classes aged 18 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats Nos. PAS015, EN1384 (USA) ASTM F1163. **AHS Rule 32**

UK IN-HAND AWARDS

At this show points can be gained for the UK In Hand Awards. A point earning, year long competition for members who wish to show in NON - ECAHO classes with Purebred, Anglo/PartBred and High Percentage Arabs. A pre-purchased qualifying card will need to be taken into the ring for the Judge to sign at the time of qualifying. Runs from 1st June – 31st May 2016

 - C - 10 + - 20 Marks for Body & Topline
 - D - 10 + - 20 Marks for Legs

If the event of a tie, the highest place will be given to the Horse with the most marks for Type, followed, if still equal, the highest place will be given to the Horse with the most marks for Movement. Failing a decision on either of these, One Judge, chosen by ballot, will name their preference.

ECAHO CHAMPIONSHIP : Standard ECAHO Method.

The Champion (Gold) will be chosen from the first placed horses and the Reserve Champion (Silver) will be selected in the same way as the Gold, from all other horses that have qualified for the championship.

1. All exhibits must be registered in their respective stud book. Part Breds with a minimum of **12.5%** Arab blood are eligible to compete.
2. **NO** person other than show officials are allowed in the show ring at any time.
3. First and second prizewinners of each class must present themselves for the appropriate championship.
4. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property servants or animals in connection with, or arising from this show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters whatsoever.
5. Any objection that may arise must be promptly lodged with the Secretary accompanied by a deposit of £50.00 - which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
6. Nomination entries will **NOT** be allowed.
7. The Judge's decision is final.
8. Depending on the number of entries received classes may be divided amalgamated or cancelled at the discretion of the Show Committee.
9. No outside interference either physical or vocal is allowed.
10. Any horse that leaves the ring after entering for judging or before the end of the class will be counted as eliminated.
11. All Three Year Old Colts must be bitted. Horses must be under control at all times.
12. Car parking is at the shows discretion
13. Eyelashes must be left uncut, hair inside the ears left unshaved and tactile hair left intact around the nose, muzzle and below the eyes.
14. In the interests of safety and the enjoyment of the show, the committee reserves the right to refuse entry to its show to any person failing to comply with the respects of their officials, officer stewards and assistants in car/lorry parks, stable and show rings.
16. Age of all exhibits will date as from 1st January in year of birth.
17. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee and Photostat copy of registration document, which should reach the Show Secretary postmarked **11th June 2016** or before. No late entries will be accepted. Entry fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** unless a veterinary certificate is produced.
18. The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring.
19. Dogs and any other such animals must be kept under strict control at all times.
20. No person shall be mounted on a horse on the showground unless he/she is wearing a correctly fitting hard hat. The AHS strongly recommend that hats conform to the standards EN1384 / BSEN1384 or PAS 015 and are correctly fitted with chinstraps.
21. Competitors are responsible for the actions of any non competitor employed by them or assisting them or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non competitors.
22. No animal suffering from a contagious disease may be brought onto the showground.
23. Riders must only 'work in' in the designated area.
24. All Cups/Trophies remain the property of the North Staffs Arabian Horse Group and the acceptance of a Cup/Trophy by the holder is a guarantee that the Cup/Trophy will be returned to the Trophy Secretary, free of cost, **ONE MONTH** prior to the following show and in good condition. In the event of the loss of a Cup/Trophy the amount of its value is to be made good to the North Staffs Arabian Horse Group by the holder. All Cups/Trophies are to be collected and must be signed for by the winning competitor.
25. It is a condition of entry that exhibitors conform with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and for ensuring that safe working practices are followed by themselves, their employees, Agents and Contractors. Exhibitors shall at all times comply with the instructions of the Show Officials.
26. **Foals** (a) must not be shown in chains. (b) Foals under 6 months old must be accompanied by their dams at all times. (c) No brood mare or her foal may be shown in any class unless the foal is at least 30 days old on the day of judging.
27. Ridden Class exhibits must wear conventional and well-maintained 'English' tack. The judge may refuse to ride or judge a horse he/she deems the tack to be unsafe or unsuitable.
28. Mounting Blocks - All ridden horses should be familiar with being mounted from a **MOUNTING BLOCK**. All horses should be trained to stand quietly when a Judge mounts. **Judges may refuse to ride any horse, which does not stand quietly to be mounted.**
29. All entries are taken as an acceptance of the above rules and conditions and acceptance of the AHS rules.

Foal Classes

In those shows where foal classes are held:

- a) Foals may not compete in EAHSC Championships, nor will they qualify for any future Title or A Show.
- b) When foal classes are organized at EAHSC affiliated shows, the EAHSC Rules will apply.
- c) Foals must have a minimum age of four weeks at the date of the show, and must be shown at foot (with the dam) up to 6 months of age. Orphaned or rejected foals under six month may not be shown.
- d) The use of metal halters and halters with metal chains is forbidden.
- e) A comparative judging system is recommended.
- f) All the rules pertaining to foal classes must be clearly indicated in the schedule and the catalogue.
- g) With regards to stricter rules for the welfare of foals, organisers may introduce their own rules as long as these are presented to ECAHO for approval prior to sending out the schedule and are clearly stated in the show schedule and catalogue.

Foals - for identification purposes:

Foals under six months shown in foal classes with their own mother need no special documentation, but the mother must have all necessary documents.

Foals over 6 months shown without their dam, foals from Embryo Transplant or foals with foster mothers which are shown in foal classes and do not yet have a passport, must be micro-chipped and in possession of a copy of the official Stud Book Registration form, showing the micro-chip number and the graphic description of the
